

The Sunshine State Education and Research Computing Alliance (SSERCA) will be holding an industry day on July 24, 2017 at the University of Central Florida. The purpose of the meeting is to give hardware, software, and system integration vendors the opportunity to explain their high performance and research computing products to interested faculty and students, as well as HPC and research computing administrators. SSERCA members will advertise this event at their individual institutions.

There is no cost for participating in this event which will be held at the Institute for Simulation and Training (address below). Space is limited, though, and only the first 14 respondents will be able to participate. Participants will be provided with small tables and chairs which will be arranged near the wall where power is available. Vendors are advised to bring power strips if they need to power any equipment they may bring. The event will start at 9:00 am, but vendors can set up as early as 8:00 am. The event will conclude at 4:00 pm. During the day, a small number of offices can be scheduled for 1 hour blocks for vendors to discuss products and performance in a more secure environment. **Vendors that wish to have NDA discussions should make their NDA agreements available as soon as possible to allow for processing at the individual institutions.**
