1. Vendor Question: I would like to know if I can access the previous bid results to this project. If any.

UCF Answer: The awarded amounts for last years bid are below. Keep in mind this bid was only for painting. The current ITN is for both painting and cleaning.

Towers 1 & 2: \$79,210

Towers 2 & 3: \$83,840

2. Vendor Question: We want to confirm, if we are the ones that must provide all the materials, for example: painting materials, tarps, rollers, cleaning supplies, etc. (UPI Special Cream flat, B30WW6151, Sumptuous Peach- B20W4651, UPI Special Cream Gloss- B31WW5251).

UCF Answer: UCF supplies paint only. All other materials/supplies, etc. that are required to complete the scope of work are the responsibility of the vendor.

3. Vendor Question: To be clear, we must itemize the pricing by bedroom, bathroom and common space, right?

UCF Answer: Pricing is to be provided in the chart listed in section 3.2, D. of the ITN document.

4. Vendor Question: Drywall repairs and extras must be itemized as an extra charge? If not, where or how should they be displayed? Or they must be included in the painting price?

UCF Answer: Repairs requiring the use of pieces of drywall (gypsum board) should be communicated to the UCF project manager. Drywall repairs that only require drywall compound should be accounted for in the bidding of this scope. (pin holes, damage from tape, etc)
